"The clearing of rainforest land for **cattle pasture** is one of the largest destroyers of rainforest, especially in Central America and Brazil. This beef, cheaper than domestic meat, is imported into the US and used in processed beef products [...]."

"[F]ifty-five square feet of rainforest is destroyed for every quarter pound hamburger that comes from a cleared rainforest. That's the size of a small kitchen!"²

"In Central America, **two-thirds** of lowland tropical forests have been turned into pasture since 1950. Meat is too expensive for many of the poor in these beef-exporting countries, yet in some cases cattle have ousted highly productive traditional agriculture."

Try vegetarian.
