Chords (chorus): *bm* *F* *G* *am* | *F* *C* - *B7* |
 E *am* *dm* *C* | *E7* + + + | (*slide the two fingers up one fret at each +*)

Chords (bridge): *F* *E* - - | *F* *E* *C7* - |

Verse:

Chorus:
